

ORDINANCE NO. 3857A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 163A WHICH ORDINANCE PRESCRIBES PROCEDURE TO AMEND CHARTER BY SUBMITTING AMENDMENTS TO THE PEOPLE BY ADDING SECTION 8a REGULATING THE BALLOT TITLE AND LIMITING IT TO 100 WORDS AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a new section shall be added to Ordinance No. 163A, known as Section 8a, which shall read as follows:

Section 8a. All ballot titles shall be submitted to or prepared by the City Attorney and shall not exceed 100 words for the purpose clause and eight words for the caption.

Section 2. That any and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
