AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 271, THE INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM ORDINANCE, BY ADDING SECTION 8a, REGULATING AND LIMITING BALLOT TITLES TO 100 WORDS AND THE CAPTION TO EIGHT WORDS AND ALLOWING POSTING OF NOTICES OF ELECTION AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a new section shall be added to Ordinance No. 271 known as Section 8a which shall read as follows:

Section 8a. All ballot titles shall be submitted to or prepared by the City Attorney and shall not exceed 100 words for the purpose clause and eight words for the caption.

Where a newspaper is not published in the City of Warrenton, the full text and ballot title and numbers of each measure are to be posted in three public places in each precinct once a week for two consecutive weeks not later than fifteen (15) days before the election.

Section 2. That any and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
