

ORDINANCE NO. 396A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 17 OF ORDINANCE NO. 342-A IN REGARD TO WATER RATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 17 of Ordinance No. 342-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 17. Schedule of water meter rates, including fluoridation.

Minimum meter charge within city \$2.25 - outside city \$2.50 minimum meter rate. The City Commission may fix a flat rate for use of water without meter. The flat rate within the City shall now be \$2.75 per month, including fluoridation. Property owners will be held responsible for water rates as well as the tenant, and for unpaid bills the service will be shut off and remain shut off until unpaid accounts are paid by the owner or tenant.

Every water account within the City of Warrenton shall be and hereby is charged an additional sum of 25¢ per month for sewage. This shall be an additional rate to any other rate charged by this Ordinance, and shall be put into a reserve fund to be used in the future for the cost of planning, constructing or operating a sewage disposal system."

Section 2. That inasmuch as the use of water is an emergency and the water rates need changing in order that the water department may operate on a sound financial basis an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
