AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32 OF ORDINANCE NO. 342-A IN REGARD TO SEWAGE CHARGES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 32 of Ordinance No. 342-A is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 32. Water may be shut off--On failure to comply with the rules and regulations established as a condition to the use of water, or to pay water rates, including fluoridation plus sewage charges, in the time and manner herein provided, water may be shut off the offending premises.

Section 2. That inasmuch as sewage disposal, water and fluoridation are health matters an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, this ordinance shall be put in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
