AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 271, INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM ORDINANCE BY ADDING SECTION 6a IN REGARD TO BALLOTS AND BALLOT TITLES AND REPEALING PARAGRAPH 3 OF SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 271.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 271, Initiative and Referendum Ordinance be amended by adding Section 6a to read as follows:

Where measures are proposed by Initiative and Referendum, the ballot title shall consist of a caption not exceeding six words in length by which the measure is commonly referred to or spoken of, followed by an abbreviated statement not exceeding 100 words in length of the chief purpose of the measure. The first measure shall be numbered 51 in numerals, and succeeding measures shall be numbered consecutively 52, 53, 54, etc., to and including 100, at each election. The measures shall be voted on by Yes or No vote.

Section 2. That Paragraph 3 of Section 6 of Ordinance No. 271 be and is hereby repealed.
