AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 163A WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE METHOD OF SUBMITTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND MEASURES BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON TO THE LEGAL VOTERS AT SPECIAL ELECTIONS, ETC., BY ADDING SECTION 5a IN REGARD TO BALLOTS AND BALLOT TITLES AND THE NUMBERING THEREOF AND REPEALING SECTION 7 OF SAID ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO.400 A

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 163A be amended by adding Section 5a to read as follows:

"Section 5a. (1) The Auditor and Police Judge shall cause ballots for general and special elections to be prepared and printed.

(2) Where amendments to the Charter or measures are submitted by the Commissioners of the City to the legal voters of the City, the ballot title shall consist of a caption not exceeding six words in length by which the measure is commonly referred to or spoken of, followed by an abbreviated statement not exceeding 100 words in length of the chief purpose of the measure. The first measure or amendment shall be numbered 51 in numerals, and succeeding measures or amendments shall be numbered consecutively 52, 53, 54, etc., to and including 100, at each election. The measures shall be voted on by a Yes or No vote.

Section 2. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 163A be and is hereby repealed.
