ORDINANCE NO. <u>41577</u> Introduced by Commissioner <u>George Huckketh</u> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TRAFFIC ORDINANCE NO. 380A BY ADDING SECTION 15a IN REGARD TO PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 15a is hereby added to Ordinance No. 380A to read as follows:

SECTION 15a, Penalties: Although penalties are provided in Ordinance 380A, any person violating any provision of Ordinance 380A shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by fine not to exceed \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not to exceed 150 days, or both, but in no event shall they exceed the penalties provided in Oregon Revised Statutes as set out in Warrenton Ordinance No. 380A.

Section 2. WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes provides in some places a maximum over that of the City of Warrenton's Charter, it is deemed necessary that an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately operative from and after its passage by the City Commissioners.
