AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A FINANCIAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING, MAINTAINING, CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, EXTENDING AND IMPROVING THE WATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE NO. 4247

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Under authority of Oregon Revised Statutes, including Sections 280.040, 280.100 and 280.110 and 294.347, the City of Warrenton hereby establishes a Financial Reserve Fund for the purpose of repairing, maintaining, constructing, reconstructing, extending and improving the water system of the City.

Section 2. Because water is a necessity for the public health and safety of the residents and inhabitants of the City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
