

ORDINANCE NO. 432A

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND CLERKS AND POSTING OF NOTICES THEREFOR FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 6TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D. 1962, FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO COMMISSIONERS TO FILL POSITIONS NOS. 4 and 5, OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, COUNTY OF CLATSOP, STATE OF OREGON FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS FROM THE 2ND DAY OF JANUARY, 1963, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a General Election as provided by the Charter and Amendments thereto of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the 6th day of November, A.D., 1962, to fill Positions Nos. 4 and 5, for the election of two Commissioners/for a term of four years from the 2nd day of January, 1963, and that the entire City of Warrenton shall constitute two election precincts with the polling places at the Fire Station in the City of Warrenton and at the City Hall of the City of Warrenton, the address and boundary of each of these polls to be described later in this Ordinance, said polls to be open from eight o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening, without closing, as by the Charter provided:

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Anna Tetlow, Barbara Knotts and Esther Bierholz be and they are hereby appointed Judges, and Lettie Kindred and Thelma Fitcha be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Election to be held in the City of Warrenton on the 6th day of November, 1962, and they are hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of election precinct No. 1 which is hereby declared to be the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said General Election as by law provided.

Section 2. That the boundaries of election precinct No. 1 of the City of Warrenton shall be as follows: All lands in the City limits lying West of State Secondary Highway 104, commonly known as South Main Avenue and North Warrenton Drive, except Block 9, Warrenton Addition, which is located in Precinct 2.

That the polling place of election precinct No. 1 is the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton located on Second Street in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 3. That Bernice Maustield, Iva Christensen  
and Helen Coffey be and they are hereby appointed Judges  
and ORA Combs and ELLEN SYLLING ~~HELEN~~ ~~HELEN~~  
Mrs. VERN be and  
they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Election to be held in  
the City of Warrenton on the 6th day of November, 1962, and they are  
hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of  
Election Precinct No. 2 which is hereby declared to be the City Hall  
of the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said  
General Election as by law provided.

Section 4. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 2 of  
the City of Warrenton shall be as follows: All the incorporated  
limits of the City of Warrenton lying East of South Main Avenue and  
North Warrenton Drive, plus Block 9, Warrenton Addition, which is also  
included in Precinct No. 2. That the polling place of election precinct  
No. 2 is the City Hall of the City of Warrenton located on South Main  
Avenue in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 5. That the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby ordered and  
directed to post Notices of said election in three public places in each  
of the two election precincts in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, which  
said Notice shall notify the electors of the City of Warrenton of such  
General Election, the officers to be elected, the places of holding of  
said election, and the names of the Judges and Clerks of said election  
appointed for the same, which said Notices shall be so posted by said  
Auditor and Police Judge for a period of ten days prior to the date  
set for such General Election.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the reason that the  
Charter of the City of Warrenton states there shall be a General City  
Election held biannually on the 1st Tuesday after the first Monday in  
November, starting with the year 1960, and it is necessary to elect  
two Commissioners to fill Positions Nos. 4 and 5 to help govern the  
City in all financial matters and all matters relating to the public  
health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, its residents and  
citizens and its property, and this Ordinance shall go into force and  
effect immediately upon passage and approval.
