

ORDINANCE NO. 437A

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER Egal Johnson

AN ORDINANCE RAISING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF ALL OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, EXCEPT THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONERS, TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS A MONTH MORE THAN THEIR PRESENT COMPENSATION PLUS THEIR MONTHLY HOSPITAL INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the cost of living has increased during the past year,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary and compensation of all officers and employees of the City of Warrenton, except the Mayor and City Commissioners, be and is hereby raised Ten and No/100 (\$10.00) Dollars per month more than the present compensation of said <sup>fulltime</sup> city employees <sup>and</sup> or officers as set either by Ordinance or otherwise, as of January 1, 1963, plus the monthly payment of the employee's hospital insurance in the nature of Blue Cross or National Hospital Plan, the employee's protection only, <sup>1</sup> <sup>1</sup> *not to exceed \$6.20 a month.*

Section 2. Whereas the cost of living has increased during the past year, in order to keep the employees happily employed and as an incentive to retain their services, including the police, street and water departments, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
