

ORDINANCE NO. 455 B

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 253A BY ADDING SECTIONS 11a, 11b, 11c and 11d PROHIBITING DUMPING OF ANY ANIMAL CARCASS AND OFFAL OR DECAYED OR PUTRID MATERIAL OR LUMBER OR OTHER MATERIALS WHICH ARE A FIRE HAZARD; AND SETTING NON-RESIDENT FAMILY RATES.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 253A be amended by adding additional provisions as follows:

Section 11a. No one, including the franchise holder, shall put into the City dump any animal carcass and offal, and it shall be unlawful so to do.

Section 11b. No one, including the franchise holder, shall put into the City dump any decayed or putrid material, and it shall be unlawful so to do.

Section 11c. No one, including the franchise holder, shall put into the City dump any lumber or other materials which are a fire hazard, and it shall be unlawful so to do.

Section 11d. Non-residents, for family use only, shall pay \$4.50 per year for a dumping permit or 50¢ per single trip, or more if a new rate is set by the City Commission.
