AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 364A BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 3a IN REGARD TO BILLBOARDS ON U.S. HIGHWAYS

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 364A is hereby amended by adding a new Section 3a to read as follows:

Section 3a. The City Commission of the City of Warrenton does hereby find that the existence of signs nearer than 1000 feet of each other on each side of U. S. Highways in the City of Warrenton constitutes a hazard to the travelling public travelling thereon, and that the control and partial control of such signs is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and are hereby prohibited.
