

ORDINANCE NO. 463F

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY PROHIBITING PARKING OTHER THAN PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES ON THE WEST SIDE OF SOUTH MAIN AVENUE BETWEEN SOUTH~~WEST~~ SECOND STREET AND A POINT FORTY-FOUR FEET NORTHERLY OF SOUTH~~WEST~~ SECOND STREET ON THE WEST SIDE OF SOUTH MAIN AVENUE, PROVIDING FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNS, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS trucks and cars other than passenger cars are a traffic hazard when parked on the west side of South Main Avenue between Southeast Second Street and a point forty-four feet northerly of South~~west~~ Second Street on the west side of South Main Avenue, and

WHEREAS, this is in the main business section of the City of Warrenton,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park his, her or its motor vehicle, other than a passenger automobile, on the west side of South Main Avenue between South~~west~~ Second Street and a point forty-four feet northerly of South~~west~~ Second Street on the west side of South Main Avenue.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 448A be and is hereby affirmed and this ordinance be and is hereby made an additional ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

Section 3. That the placing of official traffic sign or signs consisting of "Parking For Passenger Autos Only" on the west side of South Main Avenue between South~~west~~ Second Street and a point forty-four feet northerly of South~~west~~ Second Street on the west side of South Main Avenue be and is hereby authorized.


Section 4. That every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not more than 150 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Page One, Ordinance.

Section 5. Whereas parking by other than passenger automobiles on the West side of South Main Avenue as described herein is a dangerous traffic hazard, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and it is declared to be for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton that this Ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.
