

ORDINANCE NO. 4697

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHWEST BIRCH AVENUE AND SOUTHWEST FIRST STREET IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND BY ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHWEST BIRCH AVENUE AND SOUTHWEST FIRST STREET IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON; PROHIBITING CROSSING WITHOUT STOPPING AT SAID POINTS AND TO PROVIDE FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNS AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, where Southwest Birch Avenue and Southwest First Streets intersect there is a dangerous intersection with regard to vehicular traffic, and

WHEREAS, there are no city or state "Stop Signs" located at said intersection, and

WHEREAS, it is for the public health and safety of the residents of the City of Warrenton that stop signs be erected on the Northwest and the Southeast corners of the intersection of Southwest Birch Avenue and Southwest First Street,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That stop signs be placed on the Northwest corner and the Southeast corner of the intersection of Southwest Birch Avenue and Southwest First Street in Warrenton, Oregon and that motor vehicles and other vehicles are prohibited from crossing said intersection without making a complete stop before crossing over said intersection at either its Northwest corner or Southeast corner.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 4484 be and is hereby made an additional ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

Section 3. That the placing of official traffic signs consisting of stop signs at said intersection above described be and is hereby authorized.

Section 4. That every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$150.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 50 days. Nor a second or subsequent conviction within

one year thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not more than 150 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
