AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 396A WHICH ORDINANCE AMENDS SECTION 17 OF ORDINANCE NO. 342A IN REGARD TO WATER RATES AND REPEALING ANY OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 396A which Ordinance amends Section 17 of Ordinance No. 342A is hereby amended to read as follows:

Minimum meter charge within city \$3.00 per month -
Minimum meter rate outside city \$3.50 per month -
The City Commission may fix a flat rate for use of water without meter. The flat rate within the city shall now be \$4.00 per month, including fluoridation. Outside use of water within the city, including sprinkling charges, \$5.00 per year. New service meter charge shall be \$100.00. Tap charge only \$50.00. Property owners will be held responsible for water rates as well as the tenant, and for unpaid bills the service will be shut off and remain shut off until unpaid accounts are paid by the owner or tenant.


Page One, Ordinance.

Section 2. All Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That inasmuch as the use of water is an emergency and the water rates need changing in order that the Water Department may operate on a sound financial basis, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
