

ORDINANCE NO. 481A

Introduced by Commissioner Earl Johnson

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THAT PART OF SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 475A WHICH PERTAINS TO METERS AND TAP CHARGES AND REPEALING ANY OTHER ORDINANCES OR PART THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1. That that part of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 475A which pertains to meters and tap charges is amended to read as follows:

Service meters and tap charges shall be \$150.00

Tap charges only - \$100.00.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That inasmuch as the use of water is an emergency and the water service rates in regard to meters and tap charges need changing in order that the Water Department may operate on a sound financial basis, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
