

ORDINANCE NO. 4827

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE AND OTHER TRAFFIC BY PROHIBITING PARKING FOR OVER FIFTEEN MINUTES FROM THE STOP SIGN ON SOUTHWEST FIRST STREET WEST TO THE RAILROAD TRACKS; AND BY PROHIBITING PARKING FOR OVER FIFTEEN MINUTES ON SOUTH MAIN AVENUE FROM THE CORNER OF SOUTHWEST FIRST STREET 150 FEET IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION; AND BY PROHIBITING PARKING FOR OVER TWENTY MINUTES IN A LOADING ZONE STARTING ON NORTHEAST CORNER OF NORTHEAST FIRST STREET AND ENSIGN AVENUE AND ENDING 400 FEET EAST OF ENSIGN AVENUE ON NORTH-EAST FIRST STREET; AND THAT MOTOR VEHICLES AND OTHER VEHICLES ARE REGULATED ON BOTH THE EAST AND WEST SLOPES OF THE HILL IN THE VICINITY OF THE GARBAGE DUMP ON SOUTHWEST NINTH SO THAT DOWNHILL TRAFFIC SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT OF WAY TO MAIN TRAFFIC ON SOUTHWEST NINTH SOUTH OF SAID TWO DOWN SLOPES; PROVIDING FOR OFFICIAL TRAFFIC SIGNS, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park his, her, or its motor vehicle for over fifteen minutes from the Stop Sign on Southwest First Street West to the railroad tracks and it shall be unlawful for any person to park his, her or its motor vehicle for over fifteen minutes on South Main Avenue from the corner of Southwest First Street 150 feet in a Northerly direction.

That the placing of official traffic sign or signs consisting of "No parking for over Fifteen Minutes" on the above described areas be and is hereby authorized.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to park his, her, or its motor vehicle for over twenty minutes in a Loading Zone starting on the ~~corner~~^{northeast} of Northeast First Street and Ensign Avenue ending 400 feet East of Ensign Avenue on Northeast First Street which area is hereby made a Loading Zone.

That the placing of official traffic sign or signs consisting of "Loading Zone, Twenty Minutes Parking Only" be and is hereby authorized.

Section 3. That motor vehicles and other vehicles are regulated on both the East and West slopes of the hill in the vicinity of the garbage dump on Southwest Ninth Street so that down hill traffic shall yield the right of way to main traffic on Southwest Ninth South of two down slopes.

That the placing of official traffic sign or signs consisting of "Yield Right of Way" at the bottom of each slope where it intersects Southwest Ninth which is there proceeding in an Easterly and Westerly direction is hereby authorized.

Section 4. That Ordinance No. 448A be and is hereby affirmed and this Ordinance be and is hereby made an additional Ordinance regulating vehicular traffic.

Section 5. That every person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail not more than 150 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. That whereas without additional regulation and prohibition of traffic as described herein there are four dangerous hazards, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and it is declared to be for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Warrenton that this Ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.
