

ORDINANCE NO. 485A

AN ORDINANCE ADDING TO, CHANGING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 244-A ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE MAKING PROVISION FOR THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 14 of Ordinance No. 244-A is hereby added to, changed and amended to read as follows:

Section 14. TAXICAB RATES - RATES DISPLAYED: The following schedule of rates shall be charged and collected for the transportation of passengers within the city by all persons, firms or corporations owning and operating licensed taxicabs, and no different rates shall at any time be charged or collected for taxicab service, either directly or indirectly, through the use of coupons, rebates, commutation tickets or in any other manner:

TAXI RATES

Warrenton and Vicinity

<u>RATE</u>	<u>MILEAGE</u>
50¢	Up to 1/5 mile
45¢	Per mile thereafter
20¢ per passenger for	each additional passenger over 12 years of age
\$6.00 per hour	Stand-by time

The foregoing schedule of rates shall be conspicuously posted or placed in each taxicab and in such a manner that such rates may be easily read from both the inside and outside of each taxicab. No charge shall be made for traveling empty, whether going or returning.


Section 2. Section 21 of Ordinance No. 244-A is hereby added to, changed and amended to read as follows:

Section 21. AUTHORIZED FARES TO BE CHARGED - PENALTY FOR VIOLATION. Any driver of a taxicab who shall charge any passenger a rate of fare other than provided for in Section 14 hereof shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished, in addition to the other penalties provided, by having his operator's license suspended for a period of not less than six months or more than one year.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the objects of this Ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this Ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the health peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton may be preserved, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance therefore shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor.
