ORDINANCE NO. 4957

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING AND FIXING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON: CITY MANAGER, AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE AND TREASURER; CITY ATTORNEY; CHIEF OF POLICE; CHIEF OF FIRE DEPARTMENT; SUPERINTENDENT OF WATER SYSTEM, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1967 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary and compensation of the City Manager, Auditor and Police Judge and Treasurer of the City of Warrenton be and is hereby limited and fixed in the sum of \$634.00 per month, effective July 1, 1967.

Section 2. That the retainer compensation of the City Attorney of the City of Warrenton be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$200.00 per month, effective as of July 1, 1967.

Section 3. That the salary and compensation of the Chief of Police of the City of Warrenton be and is hereby limited and fixed in the sum of \$550.00 per month, effective July 1, 1967.

Section 4. That the salary and compensation of the Fire Chief of the City of Warrenton be and is hereby limited and fixed in the sum of \$52.00 per month, effective July 1, 1967.

Section 5. That the salary and compensation of the Superintendent of the Water System of the City of Warrenton be and is hereby limited and fixed in the sum of \$550.00 per month, effective July 1, 1967.

Section 6. That inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton because the services of these employees are necessary, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the City Commissioners of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
