

ORDINANCE NO. 5027

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6, CITY PERMITS, SUBSECTION a.OF, IN ORDINANCE NO. 444A AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 6, CITY PERMITS, Subsection a.of, in Ordinance No. 444A hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. CITY PERMITS a. Within thirty (30) days after a mobile home is used for human habitation, a permit shall be obtained from the Auditor and Police Judge or Building Inspector. Before such permit shall be issued, the Auditor and Police Judge or Building Inspector shall first inspect the premises and the mobile home and if the Auditor and Police Judge or Building Inspector finds that Certificate of Sanitation has been issued and that all the provisions of this ordinance have been complied with, a permit shall be issued, which permit shall be for such period of time as the mobile home remains on the tract but not to exceed one year."

This amended Section 6 takes the place of the original Section 6.

Section 2. Except as herein stated, Ordinance No. 444A remains the same.

Section 3. Emergency Clause - Inasmuch as the number of mobile homes in the City of Warrenton has increased and may further increase and the City of Warrenton has no adequate ordinance or regulation especially in regard to regulation of mobile homes, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Warrenton, and this ordinance shall

be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
