AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 319A WHICH IS "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR AND MOVING OF BUILDINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, PROVIDING FOR PERMITS AND FEES THEREFOR: PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 382A AND ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE 1967 EDITION IN TOTO AND ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND ADOPTING THE PLUMBING CODE OF THE STATE OF OREGON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 319A is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 382A is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Uniform Building Code 1967 Edition is hereby adopted in full and is made a part hereof by reference as fully as if set out herein. One copy of said Building Code shall be placed on file in the office of the City Auditor and Police Judge and shall be kept for public use and inspection and shall be marked "official copy".

<u>Section 4.</u> That the/National Electrical Code is hereby adopted in full and all electrical wiring shall conform to the provisions of the 1967 edition or the edition then in effect of the National Electrical Code known as "Standard of the National Board of Fire Underwriters for Electrical Wiring and Apparatus" as recommended by the National Fire Protection Association, approved by the National Standards Association which is hereby referred to and by this reference adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance. One copy of said National Electrical Code, 1967 Edition, or the edition in effect in 1967, is on file in the office of the City Auditor and Police Judge and shall be kept for public use and inspection and shall be marked "official copy".

<u>Section 5.</u> That the Plumbing Code of the State of Oregon is hereby adopted in full and all plumbing shall comply with requirements of the present Plumbing Code of the State of Oregon and with the present state and local board of health rules and regulations. Page One, Ordinance.
