

ORDINANCE NO. 508A

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A FINANCIAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPAIRING, CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, EXTENDING AND IMPROVING AND PURCHASING CITY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING FIRE TRUCKS; CITY BUILDINGS; SETTLING BASIN; MOORING BASIN; DIKES OR ANY PART THEREOF; AND TIDE BOXES AND DRAINAGE DITCHES IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Under authority of Oregon Revised Statutes, including Sections 280.040, 280.100 and 280.110, the City of Warrenton hereby establishes a Financial Reserve Fund for the purpose of repairing, constructing, reconstructing, extending and improving and purchasing city equipment, including fire trucks, city buildings, settling basin, mooring basin, dikes or any part thereof, and tide boxes and drainage ditches in the City of Warrenton.
