AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND CLERKS AND POSTING NOTICES THEREFOR FOR THE GENERAL BIANNUAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 5TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1968 FOR THE ELECTION OF AN AUDITOR AND POLICE JUDGE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, CLATSOP COUNTY, OREGON FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS FROM THE 2ND DAY OF JANUARY, 1969 AND THREE COMMISSIONERS TO FILL POSITIONS NOS. 1, 2 AND 3 OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, COUNTY OF CLATSOP, STATE OF OREGON FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS FROM THE 2ND DAY OF JANUARY, 1969, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a General Biannual election as provided by the Charter and amendments thereto of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the 5th day of November, 1968 for the election of an Auditor and Police Judge for the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregon for a term of four years from the 2nd day of January, 1969 and three Commissioners to fill Positions Nos. 1, 2 and 3 for a period of four years from the 2nd day of January, 1969, and that the entire City of Warrenton shall constitute three election precincts with the polling places at the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton, at the City Hall of the City of Warrenton and at the American Legion Hall in the City of Warrenton, the address and boundaries of each of these polls to be described later in this Ordinance, said polls to be open from eight o'clock in the morning and close at eight o'clock in the evening as by the Charter provided,

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. That</u> <u>Anna TETLOW</u>, <u>Barbara KNOTTS</u> and <u>Esther BIRKHOLZ</u> be and they are hereby appointed Judges and <u>Thelma FITCHA</u> and <u>Sally R. SMOTHERMAN</u> be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Biannual Election to be held in the City of Warrenton on the 5th day of November, 1968, and they are hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 1 which is hereby declared to be the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said general election as by law provided.

Section 2. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 1 of the City of Marrenton shall be as follows:

> All lands in the city limits lying West of State Secondary Highway 104, commonly known as South Main Avenue and Northwest Warrenton Drive, except Block 9, Warrenton Addition, which is located in Precinct No. 2 and Precinct No. 2-A.

Page One, Ordinance.

That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 1 is the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton, located on Second Street in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

<u>Section 3.</u> That <u>Ive CHRISTENSEN</u>, <u>Helen COFFEY</u> and <u>Idamae FORNEY</u> be and they are hereby appointed Judges and <u>Ethel BUCHANAN</u> and <u>Ellen SYLLING</u> be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Biannual Election to be held in the City of Warrenton on the 5th day of November, 1968, and they are hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2 which is hereby declared to be the City Hall of the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said General Biannual Election as by law provided.

Section 4. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 2 and of Election Precinct No. 2-A of the City of Warrenton shall be as follows:

> All the incorporated limits of the City of Warrenton lying East of State Secondary Highway 104 commonly known as South Main Avenue and Northwest Warrenton Drive, plus Block 9, Warrenton Addition, which is also included in Precinct No. 2 and Precinct No. 2-A.

That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2 is the City Hall of the City of Warrenton located on South Main Avenue in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

<u>Section 5.</u> That <u>Bernice E. MANSFIELD</u>, <u>Elsie H. SMITH</u> and <u>Marion SHULTZ</u> be and they are hereby appointed Judges and <u>Wilms JENSEN</u> and <u>Elaine CRIST</u> be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Bi-Annual Election to be held in the City of Warrenton on the 5th day of November, 1968 and they are hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2-A which is hereby ordered to be the American Legion hall in the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said General Bi-Annual Election as by law provided.

Section 6. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 2-A are described above. That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2-A is the American Legion Hall in the City of Warrenton located at 389 South Main Avenue, Warrenton, Oregon.

Page Two : y Ordinance.

Section 7. That the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby ordered and directed to post notices of said election in three public places in each of the three Election Precincts in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, which said notice shall notify the electors of the City of Warrenton of such General Bi-Annual Election, the officers to be elected, the places of holding of said election, and the names of the Judges and Clerks of said election appointed for the same, which said notices shall be so posted by said Auditor and Police Judge for a period of ten days prior to the date set for such General Bi-Annual Election.

<u>Section 8.</u> An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the reason that the Charter of the City of Warrenton states there shall be a General City Election held biannually on the 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November, starting with the year 1960; and it is necessary to elect an Auditor and Police Judge and three Commissioners to fill Positions Nos. 1, 2 and 3 to help govern the City in all financial matters and all matters relating to the public health, peace and safety and welfare of the City, its residents and citizens, and its property, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
