

ORDINANCE NO. 522A

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE CITY OF WARRENTON BUILD A WATER SYSTEM WHICH CAN BE BUILT FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$1,175,000 AND ORDERING ITS CONSULTING ENGINEER OR ENGINEERS TO PROCEED TO CALL FOR CONSTRUCTION BIDS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City of Warrenton shall build a water system which can be built for a sum not to exceed \$1,175,000, including engineering and legal costs, and that the consulting engineer or engineers be and they are hereby ordered to proceed to call for construction bids under certain conditions, said conditions being that the City of Warrenton receives \$975,000 in cash for the sale of its water revenue bond or bonds before the call for bids or letting of a contract to construct, reconstruct, repair, extend and improve the water system of the City of Warrenton, both within and without the city limits.

Section 2. That inasmuch as water is a health matter and the old wooden pipes are breaking, rotting out and leaking and a new or improved system is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
