ORDINANCE NO. 5257

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 444-A ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING MOBILE HOMES WITHIN THE CITY OF WARRENTON, PROVIDING FOR STANDARDS OF CONSTRUCTION, SANITATION, SPACING, PROVIDING FOR SANITARY CERTIFICATES, CITY PERMITS, MOBILE HOME INSPECTION PROCEDURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" AS AMENDED, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION, SECTION 11, TO SAID ORDINANCE, GRANTING SPECIAL TEMPORARY PERMITS AT BUSINESS, INDUSTRIAL AND CONSTRUCTION SITES WITHIN THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section, Section 11, is added to Ordinance No. 444-A to read as follows:

Section 11. A watchman or attendant who works or works, sleeps and lives in a mobile trailer at a business, industrial and the mobile trailer permitted there or construction site may be allowed to do so/where the owner or manager of said business, industry or construction project comes before the City Commission and asks for a temporary permit, which may be granted by the City Commission. However, the terms of the permit will be set by the City Commission. The permit can be cancelled by the City Commission at any time. Said application must be in writing and in a form prescribed by the City Commission and each permit shall be granted of necessity only and last only as long as the necessity exists.

<u>Section 2.</u> Inasmuch as in certain instances there is a necessity and an emergency exists because of it for the use of a mobile home in the City limits, an emergency is hereby declared to exist for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
