

ORDINANCE NO. 536A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 204 OF ORDINANCE NO. 524A BY ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH TO SAID SECTION 204 IN REGARD TO PROPERTY WITHIN 170 FEET OF A CITY SEWER MAIN AND FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 524A BY ADDING PARAGRAPH g. TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION 901 IN REGARD TO FEES AND CHARGES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there is hereby added to Article II, Section 204 of Ordinance 524A the following paragraph:

"Where property is within 170 feet of a city sewer main as set out in Section 204, but no sewer main is immediately available although a public right of way exists, then the City shall extend the standard four-inch service from the nearest main along an available public right of way for a distance not to exceed 100 feet, provided further that the hookup fee is paid in full".

Section 2. That there is hereby added to Article IX, Section 901 of Ordinance 524A the following paragraph g.:

"g. Buildings served through one sewer service line but covering multiple use of an apartment or multiple family use as well as commercial fixture unit rate shall allow the apartment usage to start with the additional unit decreasing rate in addition to the fixture unit rate of the commercial or industrial usage."

Section 3. That inasmuch as it is necessary for the preservation of of the peace, health and safety of the City of Warrenton that amendments to the City of Warrenton Sewer System Regulations be enacted as soon as possible, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Commission and approval by the Mayor, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.
