

ORDINANCE NO. 54877

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND CLERKS AND POSTING NOTICES THEREFOR FOR THE GENERAL BIENNIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1970 FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO COMMISSIONERS TO FILL POSITIONS NOS. 4 AND 5 OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON, COUNTY OF CLATSOP, STATE OF OREGON, FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS FROM THE 2ND DAY OF JANUARY, 1971 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, A General Biennial Election as provided by the Charter and Amendments thereto of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the 3rd day of November, 1970 for the election of two Commissioners to fill positions Nos. 4 and 5 for a period of four years, from the 2nd day of January, 1971, and that the entire City of Warrenton shall constitute three election precincts with the polling places at the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton; at the City Hall of the City of Warrenton and at the Methodist Church on South Main Avenue, Warrenton, Oregon; the address and boundaries of each of these polls to be described later in this ordinance, said polls to be open from 8 o'clock in the morning and close at 8 o'clock in the evening, as by the Charter provided.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Anna Tetlow, Barbara Knotts,
and Esther Birkholz be and they are hereby appointed Judges
and Thelma O. Fitcha and Sally Rose Smotherman
be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Biennial Election to be held in the City of Warrenton on the 3rd day of November, 1970 and they are hereby ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 1 which is hereby declared to be the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton and attend to the casting of ballots in said General Biennial Election as by law provided.

Section 2. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 1 of the City of Warrenton shall be as follows:

All lands in the city limits lying West of State Secondary Highway 104, commonly known as South Main Avenue, and Northwest Warrenton Drive, EXCEPT Block 9 Warrenton Addition, which is located in Precinct No. 2 and Precinct No. 2-A.

That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 1 is the Fire Station of the City of Warrenton, located on Second Street in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 3. That Helen Coffey

and Ethel Buchanan _____ be and they are hereby appointed Judges
and Elizabeth Adams _____ and Faith Christ

be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Biannual Election to be held
in the City of Warrenton on the 3rd day of November, 1970 and they are hereby
ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2
which is hereby declared to be the City Hall of the City of Warrenton and attend
to the casting of ballots for said General Biannual Election, as by law provided.

Section 4. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 2 and of Election

Precinct No. 2-A of the City of Warrenton shall be as follows:

All the incorporated limits of the City of Warrenton
Lying East of State Secondary Highway 104 commonly
Known as South Main Avenue, and Northwest Warrenton
Drive, PLUS Block 9, Warrenton Addition, which is also
Included in Precinct No. 2 and Precinct No. 2-A.

That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2 is the City Hall of the City of
Warrenton located on South Main Avenue in the City of Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 5. That Bernice E. Mansfield _____, Elsie H. Smith

and Marion Shultz _____ be and they are hereby appointed Judges
and Ellen Sylling _____ and Neva Sherwood

be and they are hereby appointed Clerks of the General Biannual Election to be held
in the City of Warrenton on the 3rd day of November, 1970 and they are hereby
ordered and directed to be present at the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2-A
which is hereby ordered to be the Methodist Church in the City of Warrenton Located
at 679 South Main Avenue, Warrenton, Oregon, and attend to the casting of
ballots in said General Biannual Election as by law provided.


Section 6. That the boundaries of Election Precinct No. 2-A are described
above. That the polling place of Election Precinct No. 2-A is the Methodist Church
in the City of Warrenton located at 679 South Main Avenue, Warrenton, Oregon.

Section 7. That the Auditor and Police Judge is hereby ordered and directed
to post notices of said election in three public places in each of the three election
precincts in the City of Warrenton, Oregon which said notice shall notify the
electors of the City of Warrenton of such General Biannual Election, the officers
to be elected, the places of holding said election and the names of the Judges and
Clerks of said election appointed for the same which said notices shall be so
posted by said Auditor and Police Judge for a period of ten days prior to the date
set for such General Biannual Election.

Section 8. An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the reason that the Charter of the City of Warrenton states that there shall be a General City Election held Biannually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November starting with the year 1960; and it is necessary to elect two Commissioners to fill Positions Nos. 4 and 5 to help govern the City in all financial matters and all matters relating to the public health, peace, safety and welfare of the City, its residents and citizens, and its property and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
