AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME OF REGULAR COMMISSION MEETINGS WHENEVER A LEGAL HOLIDAY FAILS ON THE DATE OF ANY REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COMMISSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whenever a legal holiday falls on the date of a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Warrenton, said regular meeting shall be held at the same time of the regular meeting on the Monday following said meeting date falling on a holiday.

Section 2. In that a legal meeting cannot be held on a holiday, and matters involving police, fire, water, peace, health and safety need to be taken up at Commission meetings, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Commission of the City of Warrenton and approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
