

ORDINANCE NO. 570-A

AN ORDINANCE CONTROLLING VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC;  
PROVIDING PENALTIES; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 380A; AND  
REPEALING ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Short Title. This ordinance may be cited as City of Warrenton Uniform Traffic Ordinance, and is hereby added to and incorporated in Ordinance 380A, as amended, as an amendment thereto.

State Traffic Laws

Section 2. Applicability of State Traffic Laws. Violation of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484 and 485 as now or hereafter constituted shall be an offense against this city.

Section 3. Penalties. Section 15a of Ordinance No. 380A, added by Ordinance No. 415A, shall be amended to read:

"Although penalties are provided in Ordinance 380A, any person violating any provision of Subsection 2 hereof which declares violations of ORS Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484 and 485 a violation or offense against this city, shall upon commission thereof be punished by fine not to exceed \$300.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail not to exceed 150 days, or both, but in no event shall they exceed the penalties provided in Oregon Revised Statutes as set out in Ordinance No. 380A as amended. Except as may be limited by charter of this city, violations of the ORS provisions, Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484 and 485 are offenses against this city and are punishable to the same extent provided in the statutes for the State of Oregon as now or hereafter constituted."

Section 4. Severability Clause. If a portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. Repeal. Ordinance No. 380A, as amended by Ordinance No. 415A, relating to the regulation of motor vehicle and pedestrian traffic, Section 1 thereof, Section 2


thereof and Section 3 thereof, be and the same are hereby repealed, and any parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Saving Clause. The repeal of any ordinance by Section 5 shall not preclude any action against any person who violated the ordinance prior to the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 7. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as it is necessary to provide a means wherein the Municipal Court shall have jurisdiction over violations of traffic laws for the health, peace and safety of the citizens of Warrenton, and whereas the city has formerly been using the Motor Vehicle Laws as set out in Oregon Revised Statutes, and whereas, Oregon Revised Statutes have been amended since the passing of Ordinance No. 380A in 1958, and whereas, the designation of ORS chapters by specific section number requires the amendment annually, and whereas, new offenses and new sections of ORS have been established, it is deemed necessary that an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately effective from and after its passage by the City Commissioners.
