

ORDINANCE NO. 572-A

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SEPARATE WATER SERVICES FOR EACH WATER USER AND ALLOWING THE CITY TO DECLINE TO SERVE UNLESS THIS ORDINANCE IS COMPLIED WITH, SETTING RATES IF SUCH SERVICES ARE NOT PROVIDED

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Ordinance 342A codified in Section 3.2, etc., of the General Ordinances of the City of Warrenton as subsequently amended be and the same is hereby amended to add the following at the fourth beginning paragraph of said section:

"Where water is supplied through one service to several water users, the City may decline to furnish water until separate services are provided, or the City may continue to supply water on the condition that one person pays for all water users on the same service and that the minimum charge is the meter schedule minimum per month for each water user."

That in case any portion or provisions of this ordinance should be held to be invalid for any reason whatsoever by any court, then all other provisions of this ordinance shall be held and considered to be independent of and separable and severable from any such invalid portions and shall not be affected or rendered void by the invalidity of such other provisions.
