

ORDINANCE NO. 575A

AN ORDINANCE RENEWING FIRE PROTECTION CONTRACT WITH THE WARRENTON RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the contract and agreement by and between the City of Warrenton, a Municipal Corporation, and the Warrenton Rural Fire Protection District, a Municipal Corporation, which was executed on or about the 6th day of April, 1966 and renewed subsequently be and the same is hereby renewed, ratified and affirmed to and including the 30th day of June, 1973 under the same terms and conditions as were in effect from July 1, 1971 to June 30, 1972 and the contract be and the same is hereby adopted in full except for changing the effective dates therein and is incorporated herein as if set out in full haec verba and all actions from July 1, 1972 to date are ratified and affirmed.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the reason that the Warrenton Rural Fire Protection District needs fire protection and that the performance of the fire protection functions and obligations of the city outlined in said contract are required immediately with the passage of this ordinance promptly and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
