

ORDINANCE NO. 577A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 541-A SETTING A 40 HOUR WORK WEEK FOR POLICEMEN AND PROVIDING FOR BENEFITS TO REGULAR EMPLOYEES WHO ARE NOT FULL TIME.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 541-A be and the same is hereby amended to delete from sentence one of Section 1 "Working Hours" the language "except police" and the second sentence of said Section 1 in its entirety.

Section 2. Said Ordinance 541-A shall be amended to add Section 8 as follows:

"Section 8. Regular Employees. Those employees of the City of Warrenton who are not full time employees but regularly throughout the calendar year work an average of 20 or more hours per week are hereby designated as regular employees of the City of Warrenton. All rights, benefits and privileges of the employees of the City of Warrenton are hereby granted to said regular employees on a prorated percentage of the average hours of part-time work per week through the calendar year.
