ORDINANCE NO. <u>600</u>-A Introduced by Commissioner <u>KeNNeth E Ostgard</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 541A AS AMENDED by ORDINANCE NO. 577A AND PROVIDING FOR OVERTIME AND COM-PENSATORY TIME PROCEDURES.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: That Section 4 of Ordinance 541A as amended by Ordinance 577A be and the same is hereby amended as fol-

lows:

"Section 4. Overtime and Compensatory Time. When salaried employees or department heads are required by emergency to work at other than their regular working hours, they shall be given compensatory time off at a rate of time and one-half for each hour worked. The compensatory time may be taken subject to the prior approval of their department head and/or the city manager at a time convenient to the employee entitled to the same and the needs of the city. In lieu of compensatory time salaried employees or department heads may be paid at a rate of time and one-half for said emergency work when it is in the best interests of the city and recommended by the City Manager and approved by the City Commission. Labor and extra hourly or part-time crews, if they have to be used, will receive time and one-half for overtime."
