

ORDINANCE NO. 607-A
INTroduced by Robert May

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 3 and 6, of Ordinance NO. 566A TO COMPLY WITH CHANGES IN OREGON REVISED STATUTES, CHAPTER 227, AND TO REDUCE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION FROM NINE (9) TO SEVEN (7) AND FURTHER REDUCE THE QUORUM OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO FOUR (4) INSTEAD OF FIVE (5).

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 566A is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The planning commission shall consist of seven members, appointed by the City Commission. Planning Commission members shall receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed for duly authorized expenses. Members of the planning commission may be city officers who shall serve as ex officio non-voting members."

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance 566A is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. At the first meeting of the commission, the seven appointed members who are not city officers shall choose their term of office by lot as follows: one for one year, two for two years, two for three years and two for four years. Immediately thereafter, the members shall notify the city commission in writing of such allotment. Their successors shall hold office for four years. Any vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the term."

Section 3. Section 6 of Ordinance 566A is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Four members of the commission shall constitute a quorum. The commission may make and alter rules and regulations for its government and procedure consistent with the laws of this state and with the city charter and ordinances. It shall meet at least once a month, and the city commission shall assign to the planning commission an office or headquarters in the city hall, if possible, in which to hold its meetings, transact its business, and keep its records."


Section 4. Ordinance 566A is further amended to add the word "commission" wherever inserted [commission] in compilation 10.8 by the Bureau of Governmental Research as currently on file and section 10 is further amended to add the words "or resolution" as prepared in Compilation 10.8 by the Bureau of Governmental Research.

Section 5. The provisions of this ordinance are severable if any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is adjudged by court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid; and such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
