

ORDINANCE NO. 620-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 253-A AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 455-A, AS CODIFIED IN COMPILATION CHAPTER 4-2, WARRENTON ORDINANCE AND FURTHER AMENDING THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND EXCEL SERVICES DATED JUNE 5, 1972, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 360 TRANSFERRING THE GARBAGE FRANCHISE TO OLVIN RATOZA DBA SUNSET SANITARY SERVICE AND TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISIONS FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE LAND FILL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 5, Page 5, Rates of that certain agreement dated the 5th of June, 1972 between the City of Warrenton and Excel Services, Inc. and Section 11, Ordinance 253-A be and the same are hereby amended by adding thereto the following rates, as follows:

I. Single Family Dwelling & Duplex:

One Stop per week:

Not to exceed one 30 gallon can -----	\$2.50
Each additional can -----	1.65
Each 30 gallon can or less occasionally collected, per can -----	1.00

Two stops per month:

1 to 2 cans -----	1.75
Each additional can -----	.90

One stop per month:

1 to 4 cans -----	1.50
Each additional can -----	.75

II. Apartments, mobile homes, multiple dwellings, same location, single ownership, 4 or more units:

Individual unit stops, single billing ----	.50
1 can -----	2.00

III Pick ups over 80' from roadside ----- 1/3 additional per month

IV. Land fill rates:

Minimum dump fee -----	.75
Each additional can -----	.25
bulk rate, per cubic yard -----	.75

V. Bulk container rates, including rental thereof:

Pickups per week:	1	2	3	4	5	6	Daily
1 Cubic Yard	16.80	26.35	35.85	45.36	49.50	53.70	58.85
1-1/4 Cu Yd	18.50	30.35	42.05	53.60	58.20	62.75	67.30

Rates for occasional pick up services:

1 Yard	\$3.00
1-1/4 Yard	3.50
2 Yard	4.95
3 Yard	6.95

The bulk container occasional pick up charge above may be only assessed when the appropriate authorized monthly contract rate is not exceeded.

Section 2.

The agreement between the City of Warrenton and Excel Services, Ind. dated June 5, 1972 and Resolution No. 360 of the City of Warrenton be and the same are hereby adopted and by this reference incorporated herein as set forth in haec verba and are ratified and affirmed, except as amended herein.

Section 3: Maintenance of Land Fill.

Section 3 of Resolution No. 360 be and the same is hereby affirmed and it is further agreed and ordered that the franchisee herein shall maintain the land fill by daily covering of garbage. The land fill area shall not be at a height visible from the ridge road.

It is further agreed that the city at any time in its absolute discretion can enter upon said land fill and use the city equipment to maintain and clean up the land fill, without waiving any of their other rights under said franchise agreement and resolution.

Section 4. Emergency


The City Commission finds that the effective date of this Ordinance shall be March 1, 1976 to the termination of the franchise agreement, March 1, 1977, unless sooner terminated and an emergency be and the same is hereby declared on the grounds and for the reason that there has been no rate increase granted during the first four years of the franchise; that inflation and other added costs have depleted the city's revenue from collection of garbage and endangered the franchisee's ability to perform the same satisfactorily and for purposes of maintenance of uniform billing practices on the first of the month, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall go into effect on March 1, 1976.

Section 5. Saving Clause:

If any articles, section, subsection, subdivision, phrase, clause, sentence, or word in this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not nullify the remainder of the ordinance, but shall be confined to the article, section, subsection, subdivision, clause, sentence, or word so held invalid or unconstitutional.
