ORDINANCE NO. 630-A

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DRIVING OF EIGHT SINGLE PILE FOR MOORAGE OF FIVE BOAT HOUSES AT SKIPANON RIVER MILE 1.5 ADJACENT TO THE FORMER STANDARD OIL MARINE DOCK IN WARRENTON, OREGON BY WARRENTON DEEP SEA, INC.

Pursuant to Ordinance 241, a hearing was held on Monday, August 2, 1976 by the Commission of the City of Warrenton on the application of Warrenton Deep Sea, Inc. for the driving of eight single pile for the moorage of five boat houses at Skipanon River Mile 1.5 adjacent to the former standard Oil Marine Dock in Warrenton, Oregon, and the same having been duly published prior to said hearing, in the Daily Astorian on July 23, 1976, a copy of said notice being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and no one appearing in opposition thereto.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WARRENTON

The City of Warrenton be and the same hereby grants permission by this ordinance for the driving of eight single pile for the moorage of five boat houses by Warrenton Deep Sea, Inc. as proposed in Portland District, Corps of Engineers Public Notice.

The construction of the proposed improvement shall be concluded within two (2) years from the date of this ordinance unless extensions have been further granted by ordinance, and if not so concluded, the permission granted herewith be and the same shall be automatically revoked without further act of the city or the applicant.
