

ORDINANCE NO. 632-A

Introduced by Commissioner Della Wilson

This ordinance amends paragraph 2 of Section 3 of Ordinance 592-A by reducing the remonstrances from three-fourths to two-thirds to require abandonment of an improvement and declaring an emergency.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:


Section 1. Paragraph 2 of Section 3 of Ordinance ~~592-A~~ <sup>592-A</sup> as codified in Section 2.3 of the Warrenton Ordinances by deleting therefrom "three-fourths of the frontage of the property to be specially affected by such improvement" and inserting in place thereof "two-thirds of the land to be specially assessed therefore."

Section 2. An emergency is declared to ~~exist~~ <sup>not exist</sup> for the reason that it is necessary for the City Commission to correct the discrepancies between paragraph 2, Section 3 of Ordinance ~~592-A~~ <sup>592-A</sup> and Section 38 of the Warrenton Charter of 1972 and because there is proposed public improvement set for hearing this date and that by said ~~correction~~ <sup>correction</sup> will correct the procedural rights of the affected property owners and the rights of citizens of this community.


Therefore this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately.
