AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 508-A and 521-A TO PROVIDE A FINANCIAL RESERVE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING GENERAL OPERATIONS OF THE CITY, REPAIRING, CONSTRUCTING, RECONSTRUCTING, EXTENDING AND IMPROVING AND PURCHASING CITY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING FIRE TRUCKS: BUILDINGS: SETTling BASIN: MOORING BASIN: WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES: STREETS, ROADS AND HIGHWAYS: DIKES OR ANY PART THEREOF: TIDE BOXES AND DRAINAGE DITCHES: ~~AND~~ SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM ^{HARB PARKS} IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - Ordinance NO. 508-A and No. 521-A are hereby amended to read as follows:

Under authority of Oregon Revised Statutes, including Sections 280.040, 280.100 and 280.110, the City of Warrenton hereby establishes a Financial Reserve Fund for the purpose of financing general operations of the city, repairing, constructing, reconstructing, extending and improving and purchasing real and personal property of city equipment, machinery, including fire trucks, buildings, water treatment facilities, settling basin, mooring basin, streets, roads and highways, dikes or any part thereof, tide boxes and gates and drainage ditches, and sewage disposal system in the city of Warrenton.
