AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND ORDERING THE IMPROVEMENT OF NORTHWEST FIRST STREET FROM BIRCH STREET TO DATE STREET IN THE CITY OF WARRENTON BY CONSTRUCTING A 36 FOOT WIDE ASPHALT STREET, 6 INCH CURBS, 4 FOOT WALKS ON BOTH SIDES AND DRAINAGE BY PIPING THE EXISTING DITCH ON NORTHWEST FIRST STREET, BIRCH TO DATE, AS PREPARED BY HOMER TUNKS, DORNER AND TUNKS, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, PORTLAND, OREGON, IN DRAWING NO. 76-12-1 UNDER REPORT OF JULY 9, 1976, AUTHORIZING THE ASSESSMENT OF COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENT AGAINST PROPERTY TO BE BENEFITED THEREBY;

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Warrenton has heretofore by resolution declared its intention to construct the improvement hereinafter described, in accordance with plans and specifications therefor in the office of the City Manager, and to assess upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to and benefited by such improvement, its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement, as provided by the charter of the city of Warrenton, and

WHEREAS, notice of such intention has been duly given and published as provided by the Charter, and a public hearing had thereon, and all interested persons appearing regarding such improvement were heard, and it appearing to the Commission that such improvement is of material benefit to said City and that all the property to be assessed therefor will be benefited thereby to the extent of the probable amount of the respective assessments to be levied for the costs thereof; now, therefore,

The City of Warrenton Ordains as Follows:

Section 1. It is hereby ordered that Northwest First Street Birch Street to Date Street, in the City of Warrenton be improved by the construction of a 36 foot wide asphalt street, 6 inch curbs, 4 foot walks on both sides and drainage by piping the existing ditch on Northwest First Street, Birch to Date, as prepared by Homer Tunks, Dorner and Tunks, Consulting Engineers, Portland, Oregon, in Drawing NO. 76-12-1 under report of July 9, 1976, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore adopted, and on file in the office of the City Manager, and that the cost of such improvement, including construction cost, engineering and publication expense, be assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to or benefited by such improvement, as provided by the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Warrenton.
