

ORDINANCE NO. 641-A

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET FOR SANITARY FUND; CREATING THE SAME FOR THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1977 AND CONFIRMING, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET AS PREPARED, SUBMITTED AND ACTED UPON BY THE LEVYING BOARD AND THE BUDGET COMMITTEE OF THE CITY OF WARRENTON AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is created a budget item known as the "Sanitary" fund.

Section 2. That the amounts for the Sanitary Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977 are hereby appropriated as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 3. An Emergency exists for the reason that the city may be without funds to operate a garbage collection and disposal service for the benefit of all of the citizens of the city of Warrenton without the passage of this Ordinance promptly and further will not be able to acquire capital equipment in time to start municipal services on July 1, 1977, or earlier if the current contractor whose franchise has lapsed and is being renewed on an interim basis, should refuse to serve the City of Warrenton. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon passage and approval.
