AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 30, PARAGRAPH IV OF ORDINANCE 638-A, BY INCREASING THE LAND FILL RATES AND PROVIDING A NEW CATEGORY OF INDUSTRIAL REFUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Paragraph IV of Section 20, Ordinance 638-A, "Land Fill Rates," be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

IV. Land fill rates:

Minimum dump fees	\$1.00
Each additional can	.50
Non-industrial refuse, bulk rate,	1 05
per cubic yard Industrial refuse, bulk rate, per	1.25
cubic yard	4.00

Section 2. These rates set forth herein shall insure that the costs of providing land fill service to those desiring to use it will be on a cost effective basis and to continue the existing rates would result in an unfair subsidy of those using the land fill and an inequitable allocation of the city's resources; therefore, the City finds that an emergency exists and the rates as set forth herein shall go into full force and effect immediately upon the passage of this ordinance.
