ORDINANCE NO. 646-A

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE MEETING DATES OF THE CITY COMMISSION FROM THE FIRST AND THIRD MONDAY OF EACH MONTH TO THE FIRST AND THIRD WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH AND REPEALING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE 582-A AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 613-A.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the regular meetings of the Commission of the City of Warrenton shall be held on the first Wednesday and the third Wednesday of each month and shall commence at the hour of 7:30 p.m. on said day in the commission chambers of the city hall. If either meeting day is a holiday as proclaimed by the State of Oregon, the government of the United States, or by action of this commission, the regular meeting shall be held at a date and time determined by the commission in its sole discretion, or further, may be omitted for that month so long as at least one meeting of the commission is held per month.

Section 2. Section 1 and Section 2 of Ordinance 582-A as amended by Ordinance 612-A be and the same are hereby repealed.
