

ORDINANCE NO. 685-A

Introduced by Commissioner Hugh Mason

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 650-A BY INCREASING THE RATE FOR MOORING IN THE WARRENTON MOORING BASIN, INCLUDING THE ANNUAL RATE, SETTING A MONTHLY RATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 650-A is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The charges which shall be paid by all users of the mooring basin of the city of Warrenton shall be assessed according to the over-all length of each vessel as follows:

Yearly rates shall be \$5.50 per foot, with a minimum of \$137.50 per year.

Monthly rates shall be one-third of the annual rate; the rate for three months shall equal the annual rate.

Daily rates shall be charged for periods of less than a month, according to the following schedule:


25 to 30 feet	\$ 2.00
31 to 35 "	2.25
36 to 40 "	2.50
41 to 45 "	2.75
46 to 50 "	3.05
51 to 55 "	3.60
56 to 60 "	3.85
61 to 65 "	4.15
66 to 70 "	4.40
71 to 75 "	4.70
76 to 80 "	4.95
81 to 85 "	5.25

Section 2: All provisions of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 650-A, passed March 1, 1978, are deleted in favor of the provisions set forth in Section 1 above.

Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect as of April 1, 1980, for the reason that the city is receiving contracts for moorage at the present time; that the city is processing its budget for the 1980-81 fiscal year; and it is essential for the equal and fair treatment of all users of the basin that the rates be uniform throughout the moorage year, which is traditionally from April through the winter of each year; and if this ordinance were not to go into effect some individual would be able to pay the annual charge at a lower rate, thus obtaining an advantage over other users of the basin, resulting in an unfair discrepancy.
