

ORDINANCE NO. 689-A

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR PROCESSING LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATIONS
AS AUTHORIZED BY ORS 471.210

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 471.210 provides that the Oregon Liquor Control Commission may require of each applicant for a license, the recommendation in writing of the city commission; and

WHEREAS, the statute provides that the applicant shall pay the recommending authority, in this case the City of Warrenton, a fee not to exceed \$25.00 for each application for a license; and

WHEREAS, the Warrenton City Commission feels it is necessary to increase the fees now being charged as the current fees do not cover the cost incurred by the city, specifically the investigations performed by the Warrenton Police Department and the processing by the City Clerk pursuant to the city's statutory duty as recommending authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WARRENTON does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the fee the city shall charge, as authorized under ORS 471.210 for a recommendation to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission for processing of a license to manufacture, distribute, take orders for and/or sell alcoholic beverages and liquor, is hereby set at \$25.00 to become effective on the 1st day of July 1980.
