Introduced by Commissioner May.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING UNIFORM CODE FOR THE ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS, 1979 EDITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1979 Edition, a copy of which is attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, be and the same is hereby adopted as if the same were set forth in full haec verba with amendments that the blank reference in Section 404, 501 and 701 shall all be to the City of Warrenton.

Section 2. The Commission of the City of Warrenton finds that there are structures within the City limits of Warrenton that need to be processed under this Ordinance and that these buildings may present a hazard to the public health, safety and welfare, and that an additional delay of 30 days before this Ordinance would go in effect would result in an unreasonable threat to the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission finds that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is declared to go into effect immediately on its passage.
