

ORDINANCE 700-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE No. 694-A, BY REDUCING THE SEWER BOND TAX FROM \$26,700 to \$17,464, AS REQUESTED BY THE OREGON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. That there be and is hereby levied a tax for sewer bond indebtedness of the City of Warrenton for the fiscal year July 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981, upon said fiscal tax roll, the sum of \$17,464; and that said tax, as aforesaid, is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property within the city limits of the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, State of Oregon.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist for the reason that the city must notify the county assessor of the tax levy by September 25, 1980, and without the passage of this ordinance, a tax could not be levied and the city would not have the funds to pay its bonded indebtedness for the fiscal year July 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981.
