

ORDINANCE NO. 708-A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAP TO DELETE THE MITIGATION DESIGNATION FOR 35 ACRES AT SITE 9-M AND RETAIN THE DREDGE MATERIAL DISPOSAL RESERVATION DESIGNATION FOR SAID SITE.

The City of Warrenton Ordains as follows:

Section 1. The City Commission finds that appropriate hearings have been held and notices given and having considered the testimony of interested parties, adopts the findings of fact attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Map on Appendix page A-47 of the Warrenton Comprehensive Plan be and the same is amended as follows:


The "Mitigation" designation is deleted for 35 acres of site 9-M, more specifically described as:

Bounded on the West by Northeast King Avenue; on the North and the East by the Youngs Bay Dike and on the South by Northeast First Place right of way.

Said site shall continue with the designation "Dredge Material Disposal Reserve" DMD-RES.
