ORDINANCE NO. 715-A

Introduced by Commissioner Robert L. May AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A NEW RATE FOR USE OF ELECTRICITY FOR TRANSIENT BOATS OF 80¢ PER DAY RATHER THAN METER CHARGES.

The City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinances 619A and 479A shall be amended as follows:

Section 1. Electrical meters shall not be required for transient boats. "Transient boats" are those vessels which occupy moorage berths on a temporary basis of less than 30 days. The electrical rates for transient boats shall be 80¢ per day rather than the metered rate in conformity with the Pacific Power & Light Company tariff. All electrical rates for transient boats shall be paid in advance for the expectancy of their moorage period.

Section 2. Section 7.5 of Ordinance 479-A is amended to provide that the charge for electrical service shall be inconformity with Pacific Power & Light Company general service schedule as approved from time by the Public Utilities Commissioner of Oregon. The rate shall be in conformity with the schedule in effect at the time of billing.
