AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 560A, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FOR THE IMPOUNDING AND DISPOSITION OF ABANDONED VEHICLES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY, CITY STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND ALLEYS".

City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 560A compiled in Section 6-12, General Ordinances of the City of Warrenton, being entitled "An Ordinance for the Impounding and Disposition of Abandoned Vehicles on Public Property, City Streets, Highways and Alleys" adopted on or about July 19, 1971, be and the same is hereby repealed in its entirety.


Section 2. The City of Warrenton finds that an emergency exists regarding the impounding and disposition of abandoned vehicles on public property, city streets, highways and alleys in the city, and that the 1981 Oregon Legislature adopted certain provisions in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 483 which outlines procedures that differ from the city ordinance for the handling of these matters; that the Oregon Revised Statute preempts the Warrenton Ordinance in regard to certain procedures and it is therefore in the interests of the city that the existing city ordinance be repealed immediately to clarify these procedural differences, and therefore this ordinance is declared to go into existence immediately upon its passage.
