ORDINANCE NO. 745-A

Introduced by Commissioner Robert L. MAY

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF CONCESSIONS IN THE WARRENTON CITY PARK OUTSIDE OF THE CONCESSION BUILDING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, the city finds that the vending or sale of items outside of the concession building in the City Park is not in the city's best interests in that the sale of such items could 1) increase the need for litter and refuse removal, 2) increase the need for police supervision of the area and 3) interfere with the use and enjoyment of said park by the citizens of Warrenton,

Therefore, the City of Warrenton ordains as follows:

Section 1: The sale of goods and concessions shall not be allowed in the Warrenton City Park located between Southwest Third Street on the north, Southwest Sixth Street on the south, Birch Court on the West, and the Burlington Northern Railroad right of way on the East, (which park is intersected by Alder Avenue, a public thoroughfare), outside of the concession building, except as stated in Section 2.

Section 2: Vendors and concessionaires will be allowed to set up booths in the park on the July 4th weekend from sunrise, July 2nd until sundown, July 6th, and at no other time.

Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable upon Section 3: conviction by a fine of not more than \$100.00.
